
Active workers belonging to the metallurgical sector in the province of Alicante.



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
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






What do you think people of different origins living in the same country?




Do you believe that globalization affects your life?








Do you think you have advantages in being a citizen of the European Union?

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




How familiar are you with development education?



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
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What can we do to improve the world?
